Village of Northbrook officials announced recently that they have locked in a new rate for electricity that is slightly higher than last year's rate, but substantially lower than the ComEd rate. The new rate of 4.99 cents per kilowatt-hour (kWh) for June 2013 through May 2014 is 17% lower than ComEd's new rate of 6.047 per kWh. Northbrook is projected to realize savings of \$4.7 million, or on average, \$409 per household and \$211 per qualifying small business in the first year of the program.
